Policy Making

Introduction:

Policies are guidelines agreed upon by the Board on important issues, including charter objectives.

Purposes:

1. To ensure policy is made in a systematic way.
2. To ensure the decisions of the Board are presented in a simple document form, to teachers, parents, guardians and friend of the school, when required.
3. To help provide consistency in the making of day to day decisions.
4. To ensure that policies reflect the consensus views of the Board.
5. To allow for the reviewing of a policy where there is concern expressed by member/s of the community.

Guidelines:

1. The Board will decide if there is a need for a policy.
2. Drafting of policies may be delegated to individuals or groups by the Board.
3. All final policy decisions will be made by the Board.
4. A copy of each policy will be kept at the school for reference.
5. The community will be informed of any new policies, or changes to existing policies.
6. The Board will consider (preferably written) objections to all or part of policies from members of the school community, and make changes or not as the Board sees fit.
